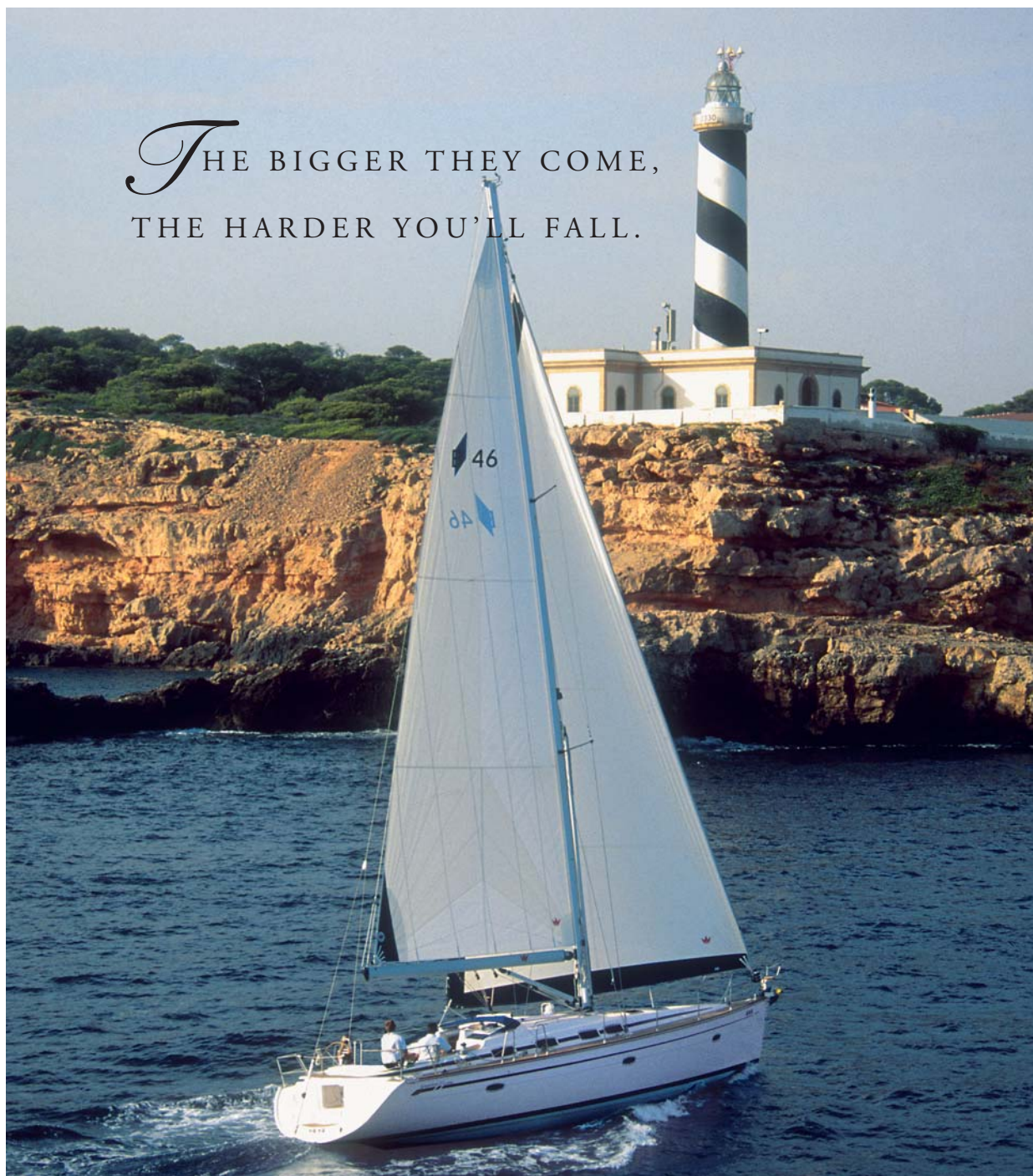

Large skylights and cross ventilation allow for a sense of openness not often found in a yacht with the sailing potential of the 46. Relax in the comfort of the owner's cabin forward or the spacious U-shaped settee amidships. The cockpit layout allows for easy sail handling or just sitting around relaxing after a lively afternoon sail.



- Six non-opening hull ports, eight opening hatches, eight opening ports and two fixed deck skylights for enhanced light and cross ventilation



- Two large heads with easy-care surfaces, rich mahogany accents and enclosed shower in aft head



- Easily worked galley with propane stove with oven, front opening refrigerator and storage in enclosed cabinets and lockers



- Three or four spacious cabins with double berths or bunk beds, extensive storage enclosed with rich mahogany cabinetry



- Powerful elegant hull lines, wide side decks, quality hardware and easily managed sail plan

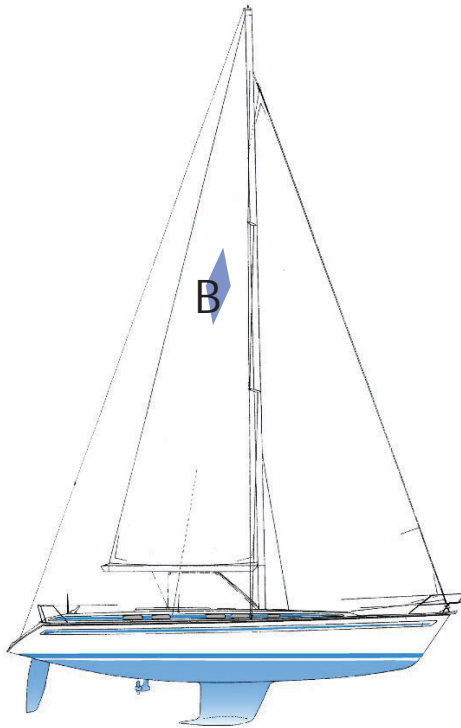


- Large owner's stateroom with ample natural light, opening hatches with roller blinds, semi-island berth and private head

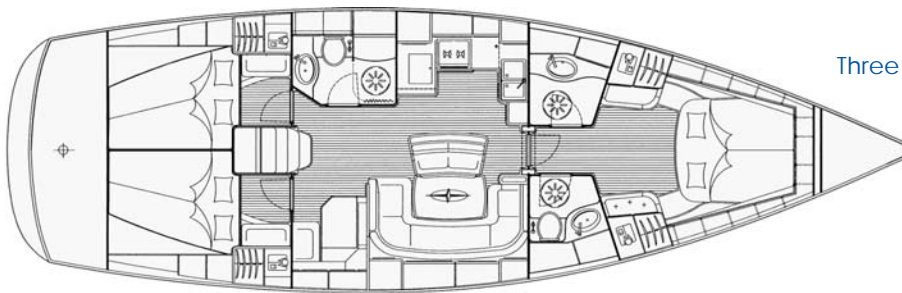

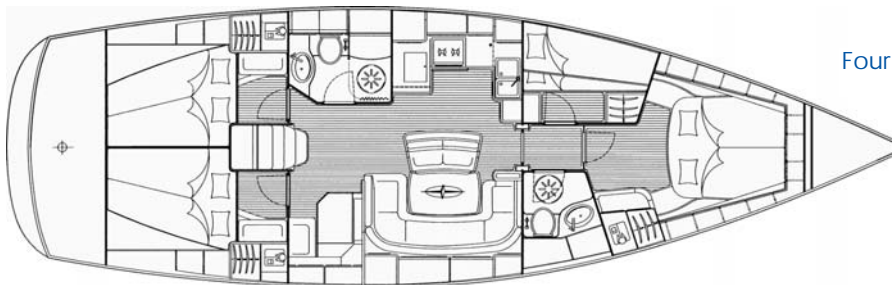

### STANDARD FITTINGS AND EQUIPMENT

Hand-laid fiberglass, solid below the waterline  
Kevlar reinforced bow sections  
Side deck and coach roof with non-skid  
Teak cockpit seats and sole  
Stainless steel bow pulpit  
Stainless steel double pushpit  
Double lifelines  
Rail opening port and starboard  
Stainless steel bow fitting with anchor rollers and chafe guard  
Four aluminum mooring cleats  
Two aluminum spring line cleats  
Two self-tailing halyard winches, two speed  
Two self-tailing genoa winches, two speed  
Electric windlass  
Two winch handles  
Sheets and halyards fed to cockpit  
Spinlock line clutches  
Self-draining anchor locker  
Two large seat lockers  
Self-draining gas cylinder locker  
Cockpit shower (hot and cold)  
Stainless steel boarding ladder - telescoping  
Deck vent  
Electric bilge pump  
Manual bilge pump  
Cockpit table with ice box

Double spreader Selden mast  
Headsail designed for furling system  
Choice of conventional, furling or fully battened main-sail  
Adjustable backstay  
Furlex furling system for headsail  
Selden adjustable boom vang

#### Ballast

Modern profile cast iron keel

#### Rudder

Twin steering pedestals  
Streamlined balanced rudder  
Rudder stock with self-adjusting bearings  
Emergency tiller  
Two steering wheels with leather covers

Shower with sump pump in each head  
Two manual toilets  
Holding tank with deck pump-out and overboard discharge  
Two non-opening deck skylights  
Eight opening hatches with roller blinds  
Eight opening ports with curtains  
Six non-opening hull ports
